Please find below a statement from the Federazione Italiana Gioco Bridge, notifying the EBL of the suspension of a player within their jurisdiction.

From the National Sports Judge FIGB:

- *For the duration of 2 months and 10 days to the card-holder **MONTANARI BRUNETTO (ITA – MNT135)**, accused of offensive behaviour towards the referee, of having contested an arbitration decision and of having caused a disturbance so as to stop the competition; therefore the suspension provision will end on **08/04/2019**;*
